



Referral Process for Bispecific Antibodies

- If you are able, enter the referral into Epic to UVA Hematology/Oncology for the Bispecific Therapy needed for your patient (free text into the order).
- Once this referral is in, the scheduler will reach out to the patient within 24 hours, and a nurse navigator will call your patient within 72 hours.
- After placing the referral, contact the Nurse Navigator for the applicable disease and treatment. This will ensure expedient scheduling and clinical handover.
